Students at Archbishop Beck are enjoying the new software programme 'Reading Plus' purchased to support students with their reading. The programme allows students to develop their vocabulary, comprehension and fluency skills as well as developing their motivation for independent reading.

The software can be accessed both in and out of the classroom so there is plenty of opportunities for reading. To ensure progress is made, students are encouraged to complete at least three thirty-minute sessions per week. They can also attend Reading Plus Club before and after school and at lunch times if they want to do that little bit extra.

A Reading Plus Achievement Wall can be found in the Reading Hub, where students can find out who is top of the leader board for the most words read. Certificates and rewards are also displayed there to celebrate the success of individual students and the progress they have made.
