- We will continue to write essays on the film. I will ask you to email your essays to me and I will correct and email back. The first essay I would like you to complete is the essay on Père Jean that we looked at. Please email to me by Wed 25th March. I will set essays every week please meet the deadlines, then we won’t fall behind.
- I will post my email address on google classroom.
