Introduction

This policy statement sets out the college's arrangements for managing the access of providers to students at the

college for the purpose of giving them information about the providers education or training offer. This complies

with the college's legal obligations under Section 42A and 42B of the Education Act 1997.

Archbishop Beck Catholic College complies with the new legislation - 'Through the Skills and Post-16 ACT 2022'.

The new guidance is detailed in the January 2023 update of (Careers guidance and access for education and

training providers) published by the Department for Education.

What this means, is students will have 6 opportunities in Years 8-13 to receive information on alternatives

pathways including apprenticeships and technical qualifications.

The information will be delivered in careers lessons, assemblies and by independent training providers who attend

our careers fairs.
